

# Tesoro High School Activities Behavior Contract

2022 - 2023

## Both parent/guardian (even if student is18+) and student must read, understand, initial (9X) and sign this agreement

All students attending Tesoro High School (THS) activities, on or off campus, are expected to know that appropriate behavior is required and that all school rules are enforced at any activity sponsored or supported by THS. Activities include but are not limited to: formal and semi-formal dances, athletic events, senior activities, banquets, pep rallies, performing arts events, camps, field trips, lunch activities, etc. Please refer to Capistrano Unified School District Student Information Handbook for more detailed information and consequences. All students and parents should be aware of the following specifics regarding school activities:

Students must be dressed appropriately at all times. This is a district wide dress/grooming standard. Students that are out of compliance with these standards, without proper attire students will not be allowed into any dance/activity until parents are contacted to bring appropriate attire or to pick up the student.

#### Dress Code for all activities:

Dresses must be appropriate length, which is mid-thigh, including side slit in leg. Slits on dresses or skirts that end above mid-thigh are not permitted.

Dresses that expose any skin in the midriff area are not acceptable, including bare sides and open backs below the waist.

Strapless / spaghetti straps are allowed.

Shorts may not expose the crotch or buttocks area

Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times

#### The following items are prohibited

Stretchy (lycra, spandex, bubble dresses, etc.) or tight fitting skirts that may creep up

Bandeau/Tube/Scarf tops or tops that are excessively low-cut, have plunging necklines or show bare midriff or sides

Canes, chains, or masks

### In addition to the above standards, Dress Code for formal and semi-formal dances (homecoming, winter formal, and prom), include the following:

Please note: Administrators or their designee in attendance will be the judge of the appropriateness of dress. Disputes/complaints about dress code will

Shirts must be worn throughout the dance – undershirts may not be worn in lieu of a shirt.

All shirts must be collared and have sleeves.

No jeans or shorts

	NOT be addressed at the dance. If your dress is in question, send a picture of you in the dress to your assistant principal for approval prior to the dance. Once students are admitted into the activity or dance, if they alter their attire in such a way as to make it violate the specified dress code standards, they will be removed from the activity or dance, parents will be notified to pick up their child, and administration will follow appropriate school-wide progressive discipline policy. 2.	All students must have a CURRENT Tesoro High School ID Card. Students are expected to carry THS ID card with them on campus during school hours and at all school events/activities. When asked by a staff member, students must present their ID card immediately. Students are expected to keep their card in acceptable shape and not alter their card in any way. If a student loses their card they may purchase a replacement at the Activities Office.  Student's Initials Parent's Initials
3.	No profanity/vulgarity. Students are expected to use appropriate language and refrain from gestures that are obscene or vulgar while at school or during school events and activities.  Student's Initials Parent's Initials
4.	All students are responsible for the cleanliness of the campus. A student is considered to have littered if he/she leaves an area where trash has been left, whether or not it is his/her trash. Throwing food (or any object) is never acceptable. It is expected that students clean up after themselves, by disposing of all trash in an appropriate trash can. This includes biodegradable items. 5.	Any vehicle may be searched. ALL passengers in a vehicle will be held responsible for any illegal substance found in that vehicle. Any person operating or renting a vehicle with 12 or more people in it, will need to turn in a group transportation clearance form to the ASB office at least three days prior to dance. 6.	No use of alcohol, controlled substance, tobacco or intoxicant of any kind. Students found: possessing, using, distributing or being under the influence of any controlled substance, alcohol beverage, or intoxicant of any kind will be disciplined according to CUSD Board Policy." 7.	All students must be respectful. Any student whose behavior adversely affects the experience of another participant or performer (i.e. heckling, shouting, use of racial or other inappropriate epithets and slurs, rude audience etiquette, etc.) or damages property at any event will face consequences which may include suspension and/or exclusion from any school related activities. 8.	Dances. In order to promote a healthy, safe and enjoyable evening for all students, the following procedures will be in place for this dance: There is no admittance to the dance after the first hour unless prior arrangements have been made with the Activities Director. No student will be permitted to leave the dance before designated time set by administration. Attendees who leave the dance will not be readmitted. If a student is removed from the dance for any reason, it is the parent's responsibility to immediately pick up the student. Students will be breathalyzed and searched. Please Read & Understand that the Dance Dress Code is STRICTLY Enforced*  Student's Initials Parent's Initials
	Attendees may be checked for possession and/or consumption of illegal or controlled substances prior to entry or during the dance. Security may conduct purse searches, "pat downs" and/or substance consumption field tests. Any attendee who refuses to comply will be denied entry.
	Each student must present a CURRENT Tesoro High School ID card at the Dance Check-In table.
	All dance styles must comply with standards of modesty and safety. Inappropriate dancing or other sexually suggestive behavior is inappropriate and will result in removal from the dance (temporarily or permanently). The faculty and administrators in attendance will be the final judge of the appropriateness of dance style. 1 <sup>st</sup> offense, the student will be given an immediate 15 minute time out and a detention. 2 <sup>nd</sup> offense, the student will be removed from the dance, (parent must pick them up) and student could lose the privilege to attend future activities.
	Ticket refunds will not be issued the day of the dance or any time after. Tickets may not be sold or transferred to another student.
	Guests must be approved by administration. A separate guest contract must be filled out. Please know that all visiting guests (Winter Formal and Prom only) must abide by Tesoro rules/dress code/dance behavior etc. listed above. Tesoro students are ultimately responsible for their guest at all times and may incur disciplinary consequences based on their guest's behavior. Guests must provide the same identification that was submitted with their guest ticket contract. Tesoro students bringing a guest must check in with their guest.
9.	Student Pick-up Times. Students must be picked up within 30 minutes after the end time of the activity. Students who remain more than 30 minutes after an activity has ended will not be able to attend the next activity.  Student's Initials Parent's Initials
