# Transition to High School

Can be a critical time for all students - a chance for growth

- Some possible challenging factors
  - School is larger, more students
  - Rigor of courses (Teachers have high expectations)
  - Failing classes creates a backlog
  - Socially there is more to do; Time management is important
- High school teachers expect students to self advocate
- Get involved in school activities High school should be more than just academics

## Tesoro 9th Grade Support

- 2022 had 28 OC Cappies Nominations (Top 5 in all of OC) & 11 Wins, Including Best Musical!
- Nominated for Best Critics Team for the last 18 years with 5 wins!

- This year had 8 students nominated and 4 semi-finalists for the OC Theatre Artist of the Year.
