Passing score on the world language SAT Test II examination with a score of 600 or higher.

Passage of the SAT II world language examination with a score of 600 or higher.

In addition to the requirements mentioned above, if the primary language of a pupil is other than English, he or she shall demonstrate English proficiency on the English Language Proficiency Assessment for California (ELPAC), or any previous or successor state English language proficiency assessment, in any transitional kindergarten, kindergarten, or any of grades 1 - 12, inclusive (California Education Code Section 51461)
